

Agreement between the Nordic clubs. (Nordic meeting 150906)

- **The yearly meeting between the Nordic cavy clubs is at the Nordic Show**

Chairman and responsibly for the agenda is the arranging country/club.

- **Membership in Nordic cavy clubs**

If a member wants another main/head club, than in the member home country, the member has to communicate to all involved clubs. Nobody can change main /head club in middle of the year.

- **Protect all breeder name in the Nordic cavy clubs**

All breeder name that are protected in a Nordic club are protect in the all Nordic clubs.

Sweden is in charge of the register and all other clubs has to check/send in all new breeder name before the club says OK.

- **Champion title, pure breed**

The first champion titel could be taken in any Nordic country. The following champion titels can be taken with just one certificate (before or after the first title). The member can register the one certificate champions in her/his own country/club. Every country/club has an obligation to send the champion list to each country in the end of the year.

- **Nordic champion title, pure breed**

From 2016-01-01 (all champion titels should be taken after 2016-01-01) you can register title Nordic champion, NordCH. The cavie has to have at least three out of four champion titels to get a Nordic champion. The member can register the Nordic champion in her/his own country/club. Every country/club has an obligation to send the Nordic champion list to each country in the end of the year.

- **Coming Nordic shows**

- 2016 Denmark
- 2017 Finland
- 2018 Norway
- 2019 Sweden

Rules for the Nordic cavy shows (Nordic meeting 150906)

1. At the Nordic Show, NM the arranging country/clubs general rules about showing classes, in checking etc are the accepted rules if this, the Nordic rules for the NM, say anything else.

In meeting 2015 Sweden and Finland have to discuss at their yearly meeting 15/16 if they will allow static lice in the Nordic shows with point taken during the judging, report next Nordic meeting.

A breed/colour/markings with full standard in two Nordic countries is allowed to be shown at the Nordic shows as full standard. If there is any breed/colour/markings that is banned due to domestic legislation in a specific country, that breed/colour/markings is not allowed to be shown when that specific country arranging the Nordic show. The arranging country is responsible for updating the list over all approved breeds/colours/markings that can be shown at the NM. The list should be send out with the invitation.

2. The NM is yearly held in September. The yearly Nordic meeting between the Nordic cavy clubs decided the arranging country. The arranging country can by themselves decide if one specific club should act as arranging club. The date of the NM should be set 1 of January. The invitation should be sent to the other countries/clubs 8 weeks before the show.

3. At the NM there are no limit of giving certifications, all categories/showing classes. (2010, change to all categories/showing classes 2015)

4. The competing in country team at NM are the ten highest placed cavies from each country (all showing classes included). The result list point out the five best cavies in each country. The point system: BIR/BIRJr/best Clipped longhair, Guide and Non standardised 25 p, certificate 25 p, class winner 10 p, BIS/BIS Jr/BISPC 120 p, 2BIS/2BISJR/2BIS PC 100 p, 3BIS... 80 p, 4BIS... 70p, 5BIS... 60p, 6BIS ...50p, 7BIS ...40p, 8BIS ...30p, 9BIS ...20p and 10BIS ...10p.

5. The competing between breeders at NM are the three highest placed cavies in pure bred from the same breeder. The result list point out the three best cavies from each breeder. The point system is the same as for country team.

6. NM titles (2009, titles for all classes 2015)

Following titles can be given to cavies that is own by a person living in one of the Nordic countries and been a member in one of the Nordic cavy clubs. Every showing classes have a title.

- BIR (Best in breed) winning cavies get the title Nordic Winner, NordV-year. Rules for the BIR is based on the club arranging NM.
- BIR junior (Best in breed junior) winning cavies get the title Nordic Winner Junior, NordJrV-year. Rules for the BIR is based on the club arranging the NM. If the club arranging NM do not use BIRjr, they have to decide rules for age comparing to their own age in classes, 4,5 or 6 month.
- BIS (Best in Show) winning cavy get the title Nordic Master, NordM-year.
- BIS junior (Best in Show junior) winning cavy get the title Nordisk Master Junior, NordjrM-year.
- The winning cavy in clipped class get the title, NordClipped-year.
- The winning cavy in nonstandardised class get the title Nordic Master, Nordnonstandardised-year.
- The winning cavy in guidestandard class get the title Nordic Master, Nordguidestandard-year.
- BIS Pet Class (Best in Show) winning cavy get the title Nordic PC, NordPC-year.
- BIS Pet Class Children (Best in Show) winning cavy get the title Nordic PCC, NordPCC-year.

7. The club arranging NM should be provide in a list of all results and send it to the other Nordic cavy clubs, no longer than a month after the show. The owner of the cavy that won a title may write the title on the pedigree.
